



Supplementary rules for Lions Gate Model A Club organized tours for 2020, in light of COVID-19.

Note: it is the Club's understanding that the following is in accordance with the requirements of the B.C. Provincial Health Officer's order issued July 27, 2020, with respect to "events". Tour participants are responsible for taking any necessary measures to protect themselves and minimizing the risk of spreading the virus to others.

1. A maximum of fifty (50) persons may attend the tour.
2. Only LGMAC members and their immediate families may attend the tour. Do not attend the tour if feeling sick or if any close contacts have COVID-19 symptoms.
3. The tour leader shall be designated as the organizer of the event.
4. The tour leader shall collect the first and last names and telephone number, or email address, of every person who attends the tour. This information shall be retained for thirty days, in case there is a need for contact tracing on the part of the medical health officer, in which case the information must be provided to the medical health officer.
5. Tour participants must maintain a distance of 2 metres from one another while outside their vehicles, unless they belong to the same family group or social circle.
6. Tour participants are encouraged to wear face masks when outside their vehicles or when riding in a vehicle with anyone outside their normal social circle.
7. Tour participants should provide their own hand sanitation supplies.
8. Food should not be shared with those not in your family group or social circle.
9. In the case of a vehicle breakdown, maintain proper physical distancing while assisting with any repairs.
10. If the tour destination is private facility, and if the tour leader is not the owner of the facility, the tour leader must provide the owner with contact information in case contact tracing is required. This may include the names and personal contact information of those attending

This does not apply to commercial facilities, such as restaurants, where the operator is responsible for following Provincial health guidelines. Please follow the guidelines of the facility.
